# EPHESIANS FAQ'S

- ◆ **Author:** Paul (Eph. 1:1) by way God our Father, the Lord Jesus Christ (Eph. 1:2), and the Holy Spirit (2Pt. 1:20-21).
- ◆ **Recipients:** The saints in Ephesus (Eph. 1:1). The church at Ephesus was planted by Paul (Acts 19).
- ◆ **Date:** Between 60-63AD, this epistle was written from prison as evidenced by Ephesians 4:1. Paul also wrote Philippians, Colossians, and Philemon at that time.
- ◆ **Key verse:** Ephesians 4:1 - *“Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called”*
